PURPOSE:

To develop a procedure for utilization of radio alert tones by Washtenaw Central Fire Dispatch.

DEFINITIONS:

Alert Tone 1 - Solid radio tone



Alert Tone 2 - High / Low tone



PROCEDURE:

- 1. The purpose of alert tones is to create an attention-grabbing noise that precedes a radio message.
- 2. Alert Tone 1 is **ONLY** to be used for evacuations as prescribed in the WAMAA Emergency Evacuation Signal Policy #107
- 3. Alert Tone 2 is to be used emergency traffic notifications as prescribed in the WAMAA Priority / Emergency Radio Traffic Policy #101.
- 4. Alert Tone 2 may also be used by the dispatcher at their discretion, when field crews fail to answer their radios when hailed.
- 5. The Incident Commander may request dispatch to activate an Alert 2 Tone if a crew fails to answer their radios when hailed. In this case the Incident Commander would direct the dispatcher to "give me an Alert 2 Tone" the dispatcher would generate the tone for 3-seconds, upon conclusion of the tone, the Incident Commander would try to hail the unit again.
